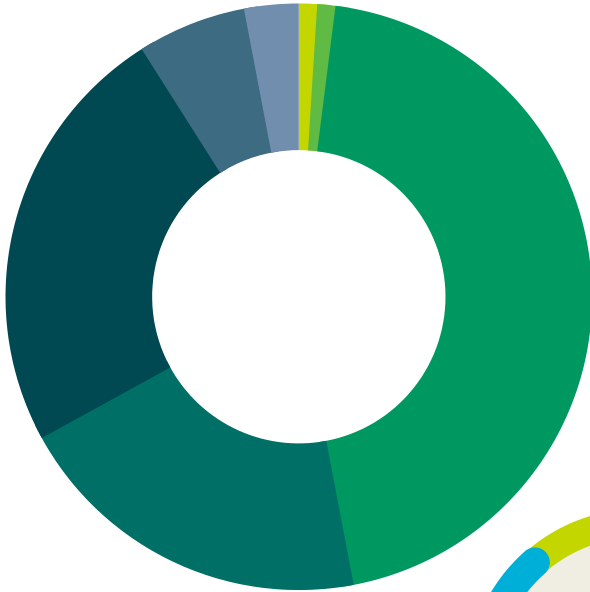

- Fundraising Expenses = 2%

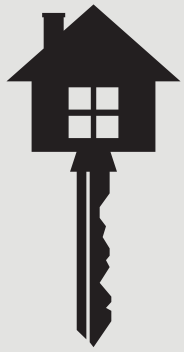
Total Expense: \$2,531,498

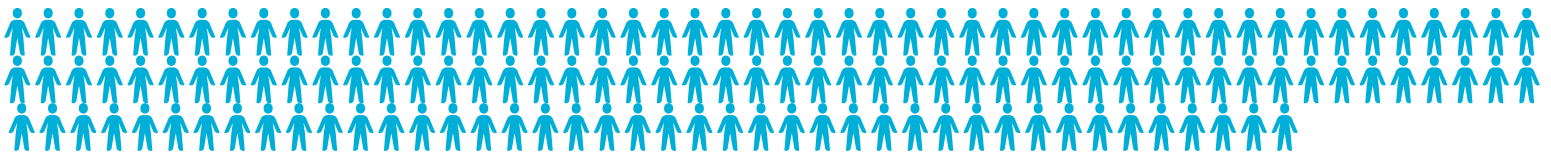
