- Fundraising Expenses = 2%

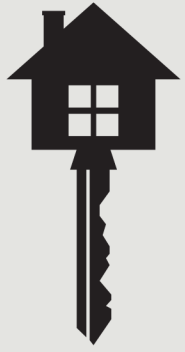
Total Expense: \$3,967,367

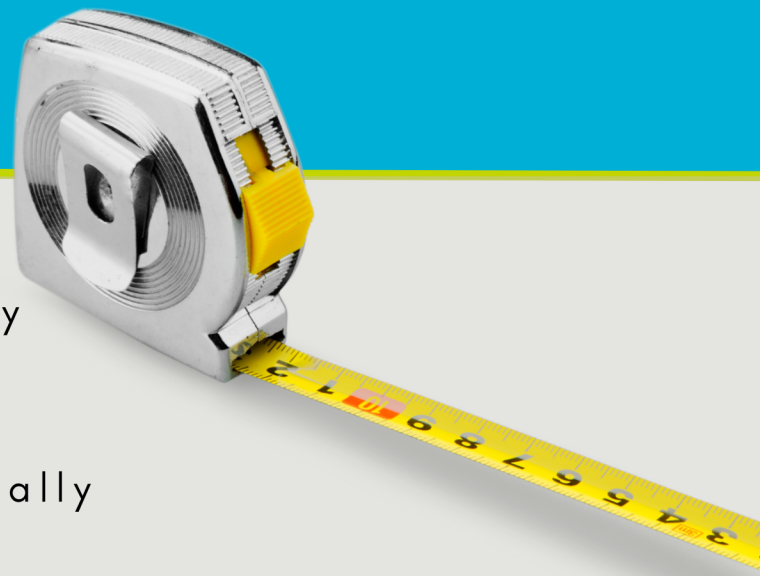

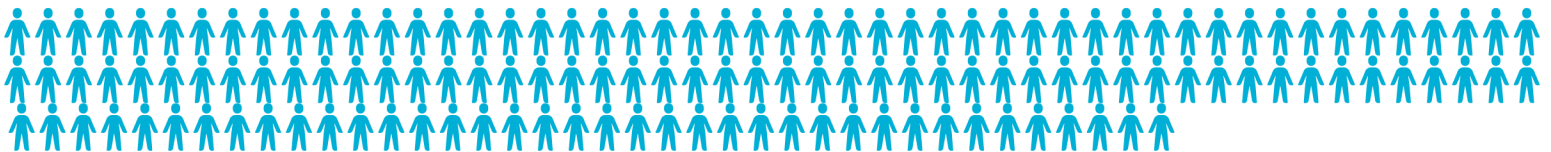
